

Privacy Notice

How we will use your data:

“AstraZeneca”, “We”, “Us” and “Our” refers to AstraZeneca AB, 151 85 Södertälje, Sweden, a company that belongs to the AstraZeneca group companies (www.astrazeneca.com). AstraZeneca will collect and use the personal data that you provided to us at a previous event, when you register to attend, and participate in, virtual and regular meetings or in other interactions with AstraZeneca. Such information may be supplemented by Us from publicly available sources. We use this information to assist your virtual participation or participation in a live event, to administer the events and to administer your engagement with Us. We process your personal data based on AstraZeneca’s legitimate interest to administrate your relationship with AstraZeneca.

In addition to the above, AstraZeneca may also process your personal data for the following purposes:

- We may contact you about feedback/surveys related to our events
- Contact you about other projects where We may be interested in collaborating with you or send you invitations to participate in future events/seminars.
- Send you newsletters about Our activities that we think are relevant to you
- The event may be recorded to collect feedback, opinions and insights for educational purposes, where you will be informed that recording will take place upon joining the meeting. The recordings will collect certain personal data from you such as name, title, video image, voice recording and any information you wish to share with us regarding your opinions. You will have an option to not show your face during a meeting, however if you speak, your voice will be recorded. The recording will be stored and made available for educational purposes to invited guests and a controlled group of AstraZeneca’s employees to revisit, re-watch and re-listen for a limited time period. Video and audio will be held for 2 years. If you disagree with the recording options, you will be provided with an option to not join the meeting.

What personal information will be collected:

We may process the following personal information or categories of data through the registration page and by using video and audio recording: Name, Location – Country, Email Address, phone number, address, photo &/or video image and voice. We would prefer that you do not mention any obvious identifying details about yourself that are not needed or relevant in relation to the purpose of the recordings (such as your personal address).

Sharing your information:

We may share your personal data with other AstraZeneca group companies and with third party service providers that support AstraZeneca in arranging our events or providing technical support; auditors and consultants to verify our compliance with external and internal requirements; statutory bodies, law enforcement agencies and litigants, as per a legal reporting requirement or claim; and a successor or business partner to AstraZeneca or to an AstraZeneca group company in the event that it sells, divests or sets up a collaboration/joint venture for all or part of its business.

International Transfers:

Such AstraZeneca entities and third parties may be based anywhere in the world, which could include countries that may not offer the same legal protections for personal data as your country of residence. AstraZeneca will follow local data protection requirements and its internal global privacy standard at https://www.astrazeneca.com/content/dam/az/PDF/Data_Privacy_Policy_v30.pdf and will apply the necessary safeguards under the applicable law of the country transferring the data for such transfers. Irrespective of which country your Personal Data is transferred, We would only share your personal data under a strict ‘need to know’ basis and under appropriate contractual restrictions (such as AstraZeneca’s Binding Corporate Rules (www.astrazenecabindingcorporaterules.com) and EU Standard Contract Clauses (http://ec.europa.eu/justice/data-protection/international-transfers/transfer/index_en.htm) or equivalent instruments approved by the European

Commission or by the Supervisory Authority). You may be entitled to receive a copy of AstraZeneca's Binding Corporate Rules and/or the AstraZeneca's EU Standard Contract Clauses upon request by contacting AstraZeneca on Privacy@astrazeneca.com.

AstraZeneca will store your personal data for as long as necessary to satisfy our legitimate business interests, legal obligations, resolve disputes or in order to establish, exercise or defend legal claims.
